### CORONAVIRUS (COVID-19) OUTBREAK

---

Following the outbreak of the Coronavirus (COVID-19) and in a bid by the Government of the Republic of Kenya to contain its spread, the following measures have been outlined affecting persons intending to travel to the country:

1. A 30-day suspension of entry into Kenya for all persons coming from countries with reported Covid-19 cases. Exception is given to Kenyan citizens and foreigners with valid resident permits provided they take up self-quarantine or check into a government designated facility;
2. Mandatory self-quarantine for all persons who have entered Kenya in the last 14 days effective 15<sup>th</sup> March, 2020. Meanwhile any person who exhibits symptoms is requested to present himself/herself to the nearest health facility for testing;
3. Consequently, the Embassy of the Republic of Kenya in the Russian Federation, has temporarily suspended visa issuance for persons intending to visit Kenya for one (1) month effective as from 18<sup>th</sup> March, 2020 unless advised otherwise;
4. The Embassy will also scale down its services to public save for the very essential ones. For further information you may contact the Embassy as follows:
